

The Church of the True Orthodox Christians of Greece staunchly cultivates the theology of anti-ecumenism on two levels simultaneously: on the one hand, it points out the ecclesiological deviations of Orthodox ecumenists at the theoretical and practical levels; and, on the other hand, it puts forth the teaching of the Orthodox Synodal and Patristic Traditions concerning the relationship between heresy and truth and between heretics and the Church.

Therefore, and for the benefit of our readers both from the faithful and otherwise who understand Arabic, we have translated the majority of these texts into Arabic and edited others from sources in the Arabic original. We have thus contributed to accomplishing our goal of enlightening the largest number of people -- whether Orthodox or otherwise who are seeking theological truth -- about the dangers of the current spiritual state in our world today where the hurricane of the heresy of ecumenism has invaded all the so-called “canonical” patriarchates as a prelude for preparing the entire world for accepting the coming antichrist of the last times.

This enlightenment is accomplished first, by embracing and practicing a correct Orthodox spiritual life founded on humility, repentance, obedience, prayer, fasting, and frequent participation in the salvific mysteries of the Church; and second, by reading and studying the theological and spiritual texts we have provided here (and certainly other books and articles previously published). Such a daily spiritual routine will lead the soul of the believer not only to its purification and illumination and the birth of Christian love within it, but also to the knowledge that enables it to discern the spirit of God from the spirit of the world and the spirit of the devil who seeks to devour us, and to crush all his machinations.
